



- The Romanian health system is in ongoing reform since more than two decades
- Few sectoral strategies have been approved by different Governments
- Their vision was rather limited to different sub-sectors of the health field
- Their implementation remained rather weak
- Continuity between transformation of different sub-sectors remained

- The 2014-2020 ESIF regulatory framework provisions to ensure the effectiveness and coordination of the ESI Funds (Reg 1303/2013)
- The ex-ante conditionality for health:
 - A national or regional strategic policy framework for health in place
 - Coordinated measures to improve access to health services;
 - Measures to stimulate efficiency in the health sector, through deployment of service delivery models and infrastructure;
 - A monitoring and review system.
 - A Member State or region has adopted a framework outlining available budgetary resources on an indicative basis and a cost effective concentration of resources on prioritized needs for health care.



- 1.2. Increasing Romanian participation in EU research;
- 1.3. Increasing private investments in research, development and innovation;
- 1.4. increasing the transfer of knowledge, technology and RDI staff between the public and private environment
- 2.3. Increasing the use of e-governance systems;
- 2.4. Increasing the use of internet (including e-health).





Main bottlenecks of NHS

- Limited operationalization
- Very synthetic section referring to M&E mechanisms
- The action plan misses the time-frame for implementation of the specific objectives;
- Targets for 2020 are not mentioned (also the intermediary targets are missing and in many cases even the baseline values for the proposed M&E indicators are not mentioned);

EC requirements for fulfilling the ex-ante

- 1. Regional plans to operationalize the reshaping the health services
- 2. Comprehensive M&E framework of NHS







- Implementation of RPs (consultation, M&E mechanism




