

General information for the ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS

APPLICATION FOR 2017-2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

For the academic year 2017-2018, **ERASMUS application dossiers** are required to be sent as following:

- for 1st semester and the entire academic year: **no later than 30th June 2017 (electronically) and no later than 15th July 2017 (original documents via post)**
- for 2nd semester: **no later than 15th December 2017 (both electronically and by post)**

The application dossier will be sent **ONLY** after the partner University has sent the official nomination of the student. **ONLY** the dossiers of the **OFFICIALLY** nominated students will be evaluated.

The Application dossier will contain the following:

- 1. Application form** - signed by the partner University Erasmus representative
- 2. Transcript of records from Home University**
- 3. Approval of Home University to study at UMF Carol Davila as an ERASMUS student**
- 4. Europass CV**
- 5. Learning Agreement** - completed and signed by the partner University Erasmus representative – for completion of LA, the students can use the published Courses Catalogue with the mention that they can choose courses from different years of study and that the schedule will be available only at the end of September.
 - The number of credits cannot be higher than 36 for 1 semester and 65 for 2 semesters. If this is the case, the initial LA will not be approved.
 - The initial LA will be provisionally accepted with the amendment that based on the Courses Schedule made available in September, changes will be applied in order to avoid overlaps.
 - Incoming Erasmus students will be mainly enrolled in English module of Faculty of Medicine with possibility to be enrolled in the Romanian module after 1 semester and after acquiring a reasonable level of Romanian language.
 - The individualized Courses Schedule for each incoming student will be established at the beginning of October by the Dean Office and it will not be changed after it's agreed upon it.

6. English Language Certificate – level B1/B2 – Cambridge / TOEFL – this can be sent later but no later than the student arrival at our University. The student can present the English language certificate when he arrives in Bucharest.

For dossiers electronically received later than 30th June 2017, the evaluation will be done after 1st September 2017.
