## APPLICATION DOSSIER

University of Medicine and Pharmacy “Carol Davila” requires an application form to be sent by post together with other documents described on University’ website (e.g. transcript of records). All official nominees received from a partner institution will be informed on the application procedures.

The Partner University needs to send us the following details for the nominated students:

- First name and Surname
- a valid e-mail address – for further correspondence with the student
- approximate period of stay for each student

The application dossier will include:

- Application form – which will be sent via e-mail to the nominated students
- Learning Agreement
- Official Letter of nomination from the Home University
- Transcript of Records from the Home University

## COURSES AND EXAMS

An individualized courses schedule will be prepared for each applicant based on the approved learning agreement and on the available general courses schedule.

For each course, each applicant should attend both practical and theoretical activities. Each course will be finalized with 2 exams: practical examination and theoretical exam.

Initially, incoming students will be enrolled in the English module. After acquiring an adequate Romanian level, they can be enrolled in the Romanian module.

**Theoretical exams:** Romanian grades range from 1 to 10. Minimum passing grade is 5.

**Practical activities / Clinical rotations:** A fail evaluation imposes a re-evaluation of the clinical rotation or of the practical activity. Participation in theoretical exams is possible only if the practical exam has been passed by the student.

Credits are allocated only at the end of the course after passing both practical and theoretical exams.
