The English Proficiency Examination – written and oral examination - for the candidates applying for the English Teaching Module will take place at the Faculty of Medicine, the Department of Foreign Languages, 8, Eroii Sanitari Boulevard, on the following days:

The candidates have to register for the day of the written examination at the Office for International Students at the Rector's Office. The maximum number of candidates to be registered per day of examination is 20.

The candidates will be admitted for the exam based on the list issued by the Office for International Students, certifying their registration for the respective date.

The candidates must come to the Faculty of Medicine one hour before the beginning of the exam, i.e. at 11.00 a.m. They shall be allowed into the examination halls ONLY after presenting a valid ID card or passport (EU citizens) or passport (non-EU citizens) issued by the country corresponding to their registration. NO other identity documents shall be accepted, i.e. another passport corresponding to another citizenship of the candidate.

The written examination will comprise grammar and vocabulary exercises, as well as writing an essay on a general topic, testing the candidates' ability to read, write and understand academic English.

The oral examination will take place after the written examination and will take the form of an open discussion, in order to test the candidates' capacity to understand and create coherent statements.

The results of the English examination shall be sent to the Rector's Office, The Office for International Students.
