PREVIOUS TRAINING EXPERIENCE:

General Cardiology: Cardiology residency training, conform the Romanian residency regulations in cardiology from 2009 till 2015, mostly taking care of emergency patients after acute myocardial infarction, acute pulmonary embolism, pulmonary oedema, acute myocarditis. Performed more than 200 24-hours on call duties and full time commitment during the general cardiology training.

Interventional Cardiology: Started since August 2013. Finished EAPCI training course (e-Learning platform, certificate of excellence in interventional cardiology) since July 2014 till July 2016. During the period of my training, participated in more than 400 PCI procedures and 800 angiography procedures, from which, around 150 PCI procedures and 400 coronarography procedures as a first operator (procedures documented in the ESC elearning platform log-book as well as personal procedural log-book). After training, worked as an independent interventional cardiologist in public and private hospitals on a rate of > 200 PCI per year. Managed to obtain both national and European accreditation of my training in both cardiology and interventional cardiology.

CURRENT POSITION:

Interventional cardiology consultant, performing coronary diagnostic and PCI procedures as a solitary-operator (no second operator in almost all interventions), on daily basis at public emergency hospital located in Bucharest, Romania. Also performing on-call duties in general cardiology beside ambulatory consultations and academic activities. Since November 2020 till present the hospital is exclusively caring Covid19 patients.

A case accepted for oral presentation in the ESC congress 2015 (Session: Nothing as it seems in interventional cardiology, organised by COT), therefore, it has been published in the European Heart Journal (ESC congress 2015 abstract supplement). This case of a 23 years old male with two abnormal coronary origins, who suffered an

occlusion of the proximal LAD, invites us to think the possible relationship between abnormal coronary origin or course and accelerated atherosclerosis through different mechanisms as micro-vascular compression and decreased shared stress.

A case accepted for oral presentation in Eurothrombosis summit 2015, out of three selected cases. The session was organised by the young thrombosis group of ESC and took place in October, 3rd 2015 in Como, Italy. The case was published in Eurothrombosis 2015 abstract book.

This case is highlighting the important balance between the risks of hemorrage and of athero-thrombosis in patients with an indication of a triple anti-thrombotic therapy (DAPT and OAC). In special cases of high risk-patients with multiple complications, it may be wise to consider the new OAC and anti-platelets.
