## The English Examination for the foreign students applying for the English Teaching Module – The Faculty of Dentistry

In order to apply for the English Teaching Module at the Faculty of Dentistry, the candidates need to have either a valid certificate issued by TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) / IELTS (The International English Language Testing System) etc, (according to annex 3) or sit for the online English examination (via Zoom) at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Carol Davila".

The English examination (written examination and oral examination) as proof of linguistic competency for the candidates applying for the English Teaching Module, The Faculty of Dentistry will take place on **Friday 2 September 2022** at 12.00 o'clock Romanian time and **on Tuesday 6 September 2022** at 12.00 o'clock Romanian time.

The candidates must register for the English examination at the Office for Foreign Students at the Rector's Office. In order to be registered, the students must send to <a href="mailto:studentstraini@umfcd.ro">studentistraini@umfcd.ro</a> the proof of payment for the examination fee.

The candidates shall be admitted to the English exam based on the list issued by the Office for Foreign Students certifying their registration on the respective day.

The examination comprises a written and an oral part which both will take place online (video and audio session via Zoom).

The written exam will comprise grammar and vocabulary exercises, testing the candidates' ability to read, write and understand academic English (e.g. reading comprehension, deciding if statements are true or false after having read a text, multiple choice questions and writing answers to questions). All of the subjects are mandatory.

The oral exam will be an open discussion, testing the candidates' capacity of understanding and producing coherent statements.

The candidates will have to download, install, and try out the Zoom software before the exam and log from a computer which has a working web camera and a microphone (no mobile phones are allowed). The camera will have to view their faces and the surrounding area. Books, notes and headsets are not allowed.

The candidates must keep the microphone and camera on in order to allow the examiners to see and hear them during the written and oral exam.

The link for the zoom session, the code and the password will be sent to the candidates one day before the exam. In order to receive all the information necessary for the exam, the candidates must have a valid Yahoo or Gmail address which should be sent to the following mail address liliana.andronache@umfcd.ro one day before the examination. The scans of a valid ID card or passport (EU citizens) or passport (non-EU citizens) issued by the country corresponding to the candidate's registration shall also be sent to this mail address one day before the examination.

The candidates will need to log in to the Zoom meeting 15 minutes before the beginning of the exam and wait in the waiting room. They must log in with their first name and their last name and present valid identification documents. Afterwards, the candidates will receive the subject in a word file with doc extension. By participating in the exam the candidates give their consent to the recording of the exam.

The written exam lasts two hours, during which the candidates must have their camera and microphone on. The candidates will solve the subjects in the same doc they have received. When the two hours are over, the candidates must send the completed doc to liliana.andronache@umfcd.ro and they must not log out until they have confirmation that their document has been received by the examiner.

After one hour (the exact time will be announced at the end of the written exam), the oral exam will take place. The candidates will have to log in again to the Zoom meeting and wait in the waiting room. The oral exam will take place in groups of three selected from the waiting room.

The results of the English examination shall be sent to the Rector's Office, The Office for Foreign Students.
