The abstract shall not exceed one A4 page with Normal margins written in Times New Roman 12

Title: The abstract title should no longer exceed 150 characters (including spaces).

Authors: Presented with Surname, first and middle names with initials.

Affiliations: Department name, institution, city and country. If authors belong to several different

departments/institutions, superscript digits should be used to relate the authors'

names to respective departments/institutions.

Presenting author: Name and Surname, email, undergraduate students must add year and field

of study, PhD students must include "PhD student".

Scientific supervisor: Student abstracts must include the supervisor's name and email if they differ

from the corresponding author.

Corresponding author: Name and Surname, email.

Keywords: A maximum of five should be given. Please use MeSH terms to define your

keywords (http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/).
