In 2014 she was accepted as a University Lecturer at Carol Davila University, and advanced to the position of Professor of Neonatology in 2018. She runs the Neonatology Clinic of Elias University Emergency Hospital since 2002.

As President of Romanian Society of Fetal and Neonatal Medicine she organized and chaired 2 National Congresses of perinatology, in 2023 and 2024 in Bucharest and Cluj and in 2025 in Timisoara.
