



Abstract Guidelines

The abstract shall not exceed one A4 page with Normal margins written with font Times New Roman 12

Abstract title should not exceed no longer than 150 characters (including spaces).

Authors should be presented with surname and initials of first and middle names.

Affiliations written as Department name, institution, city and country. If authors belong to several different departments/institutions, superscript digits should be used to relate the authors' names to respective departments/institutions.

Presenting author: Name and Surname, email, undergraduate students must add year and field of study, PhD students must include "PhD student".

Scientific supervisor: Student abstracts must include supervisor's name and email

Corresponding author: Name and Surname, email *(if different from the Scientific supervisor)*.

Keywords: Maximum five should be given. Please use MeSH terms to define your keywords (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/>).

- Clinical and Epidemiological Research (CER)
- Drug Development and Effects (DDE)
- Infections & Immunology (IFI)
- Medical Imaging (MI)
- Metabolic Disorders (MTD)
- Nanomedicine and Safety (NMS)
- Neurodegenerative Diseases (NDD)
- Reproductive Health (RPH)
- Translational Medical Research (TMR).

The abstract file must have the following name:

Institute-Research area-Surname of the author-First words of the title

Example: TNMU-CVD- Shevchuk-Thrombophilia

Notes:

- Official institutional representatives/registered team leaders within RECOOP are responsible for submitting abstracts at once for the entire institution/scientific group.
- One person can only have one presentation.
- Due to the different length of presentations for undergraduate/PhD students and scientists:
 - An abstract can only be presented by the student who submitted it, or another student co-author, if he/she does not have his/her own presentation;
 - An abstract can only be presented by the scientist who submitted it, or a scientist co-author, if he/she does not have his/her own presentation.
- Only abstracts presented at the conference will be published in the Booklet.
